

**FEDERAL ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION (FAC) PROGRAM,
\$25 FAC PAYMENTS**

This is an advisory only, and no action on your part is necessary.

The Division has begun processing the FAC payments that were temporarily stopped until the Federal Extended Benefits bill was passed. If you had an active, regular UI claim and you were receiving the \$25 FAC weekly payment prior to June 2, 2010, you will continue to receive this additional payment until you have exhausted all possible benefits on current or future Emergency Unemployment Claim (EUC) or State Extended Benefit (SEB) claim.

If you are eligible for the FAC payments, with your next weekly claim payment you will begin to receive your FAC payments again. The payments may come to you in a separate \$25 payment and lump sum **or** one lump sum payment based on:

- If your current weekly claim was recently processed then you will receive one \$25 payment; or
- If several of your back weeks for EUC or SEB weekly claims were recently processed then you will receive one lump sum FAC payment; or
- If your back weeks for EUC and SEB weekly claims have already been paid, the lump sum FAC payment will be sent after August 30, 2010.

The weekly \$25 FAC payment program will continue until the benefit week ending December 11, 2010, as long as you have a balance on your claim.

You do not need to contact the Telephone Claim Center upon receipt of these payments by check or after it has been deposited to your debit card.
