



The State of Nevada Department of Employment, Training and Rehabilitation (DETR) is excited to announce the launch of a new, improved Nevada State Job Bank website at <http://www.jobcentral.org/nv>. The new website will allow businesses to post job openings, view resumes and promote employment opportunities within your organization. It will also offer additional benefits such as:

- More exposure for your jobs
- Quicker posting to the National Labor Exchange and partner sites
- No charge usage

If you previously had an America's Job Exchange (AJE) account, for your convenience, we have automatically transferred your account registration information to the new website. To access your account for the first time, click on "*Create/Login to Your Employer Account*" on the website's home page. Enter your email address and then click on "*Forgot Password?*" to retrieve your account password. If you did not have a previous account, under the employer section, click on the "Create Employer Account" and follow the instructions.

Make sure to check out the new "Indexing" feature which may allow you to stop manually posting jobs! If you have a corporate career site, find out how to automatically post your jobs by clicking on the [Include My Jobs](#) link at the bottom of any page on the website.

The new Nevada Job Bank is being hosted by DirectEmployers Association (DE) as part of the JobCentral National Labor Exchange (NLX). NLX is a unique public/private partnership operated in conjunction with the National Association of State Workforce Agencies (NASWA). Therefore, the new Nevada Job Bank was designed and built with needs of businesses in mind.

Please note that effective October 4, 2010, the Nevada State Job Bank will move to the new address of <http://www.jobcentral.org/nv>. As always, the services provided to businesses and jobseekers by DETR will be free of charge on this site.

Posting jobs with either the JobCentral Job Bank or Nevada JobConnect will satisfy the mandatory job listing as required by the Office of Federal Contract Compliance Programs (OFCCP).
